Victorian	The South End has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the largest Victorian brick row house district in the United States. \$5,000 admission for 8
Cyclorama	Built in 1884 to display a panoramic painting, the Cyclorama was a precursor to the movie theater and is on the National Register of Historic Places. \$2,500 admission for 4
Gateway	The Washington Gateway Main Street was selected as one of 11 semifinalists in the Great American Main Street Awards. \$1,000 admission for 2
